## B: Choose One From Each Column:

<p><b>WRITE YOUR OWN POEM</b></p> <p>Write an 8 stanza poem, employing 3 distinct techniques drawn from Coleridge's Rime of the Ancient Mariner (Like the rhythm and rhyme)</p> <p><b>ANALYSE LANGUAGE</b></p> <p>Choose 4 stanzas from the poem and annotate them for their use of language features</p>	<p><b>RECITE BY HEART</b></p> <p>Choose your favourite 8 stanzas, learn them by heart and recite them to the class</p> <p><b>LECTURE</b></p> <p>Devise a 10 minute lesson for the class on a key aspect of Coleridge's poem play like its figurative language or moral message.</p>	<p><b>PAINT A SCENE</b></p> <p>Paint a scene as it is described in The Rime of the Ancient Mariner</p> <p><b>MAKE A MODEL</b></p> <p>Make a model of something described in The Rime of the Ancient Mariner (for example, the ghost ship, the iceberg, the albatross or the spirit in the sea)</p>
